Overview**

American Fisheries Society Mission Statement

The mission of the Society is to improve the conservation and sustainability of fishery resources and aquatic ecosystems by advancing fisheries and aquatic science and promoting the development of fisheries professionals.

Grant Overview: The Idaho Chapter of the American Fisheries Society has a long history of promoting aquatic education efforts. In 2013, the Chapter formally established an Aquatic Education/Trout-in-the-Classroom Grant to assist Idaho K-12 teachers with aquatic education efforts. The grants can support transportation costs for aquatic education field trips.

Grant Amount: There is no limit on the grant request amount. However, depending on how many applications we receive we may not be able to fund all trips for the full requested amount.

Eligibility: Any Idaho K-12 classroom

To apply for field trip grants:

1. Complete and submit the grant application form at <https://www.idahoafs.org/aquaticEdTICgrants.php>
2. We will respond with an award letter and instructions to get the invoice paid.

Applications received by **March 20th** will be prioritized for funding. We will accept applications after that date until all grant money is allocated.

Post-field trip grant follow up requirements:

1. Submit an invoice/bill from your school or transportation company by June 30th.
